Science Fair Rules

By participating in the Science Fair, sponsored by Rotary Central Cayman Islands Ltd (“Rotary Central”), all participants/entrants agree to be bound by the following rules:

1. You must choose one of the four Project Categories in which you wish to enter your project:
 - Life science: including micro- biology, botany or zoology
 - Earth science: environment, weather astronomy and ecology
 - Physics, chemistry and computer science
 - Food and health
2. Where in the opinion of the Science Fair judges the Project Category you have chosen is inappropriate for your project, your project may be re-assigned by the judges to a different Project Category.
3. Your project must be safe and may not involve toxic, flammable, or other hazardous materials, nor otherwise pose a hazard or danger to yourself or others. Rotary Central reserves the right to exclude any project which in its opinion or in the opinion of the judges is inappropriate, unsafe or hazardous.
4. You agree to be bound by the scoring and decisions of the Science Fair judges, and the determination of, and awarding of prizes by Rotary Central. All such decisions are final. See the Judge’s Scoring Sheet posted on Rotary Central’s Science Fair website for guidance as to the scoring of your Science Fair project.
5. Particularly in the case where there are a limited number of entries in a given Project Category, the Science Fair judges will determine whether your project and the scoring assigned to it by the Science Fair judges merits a prize in that Project Category. In other words if there is one entry in a Project Category that project does not automatically receive first prize in that Project Category, but is determined based on merit and the assessment of the Science Fair judges.
6. Your project should be your own work. Adults may offer guidance, and may supervise the investigation, but should not take an active role in the project except in cases of safety.
7. Above all - have fun!
